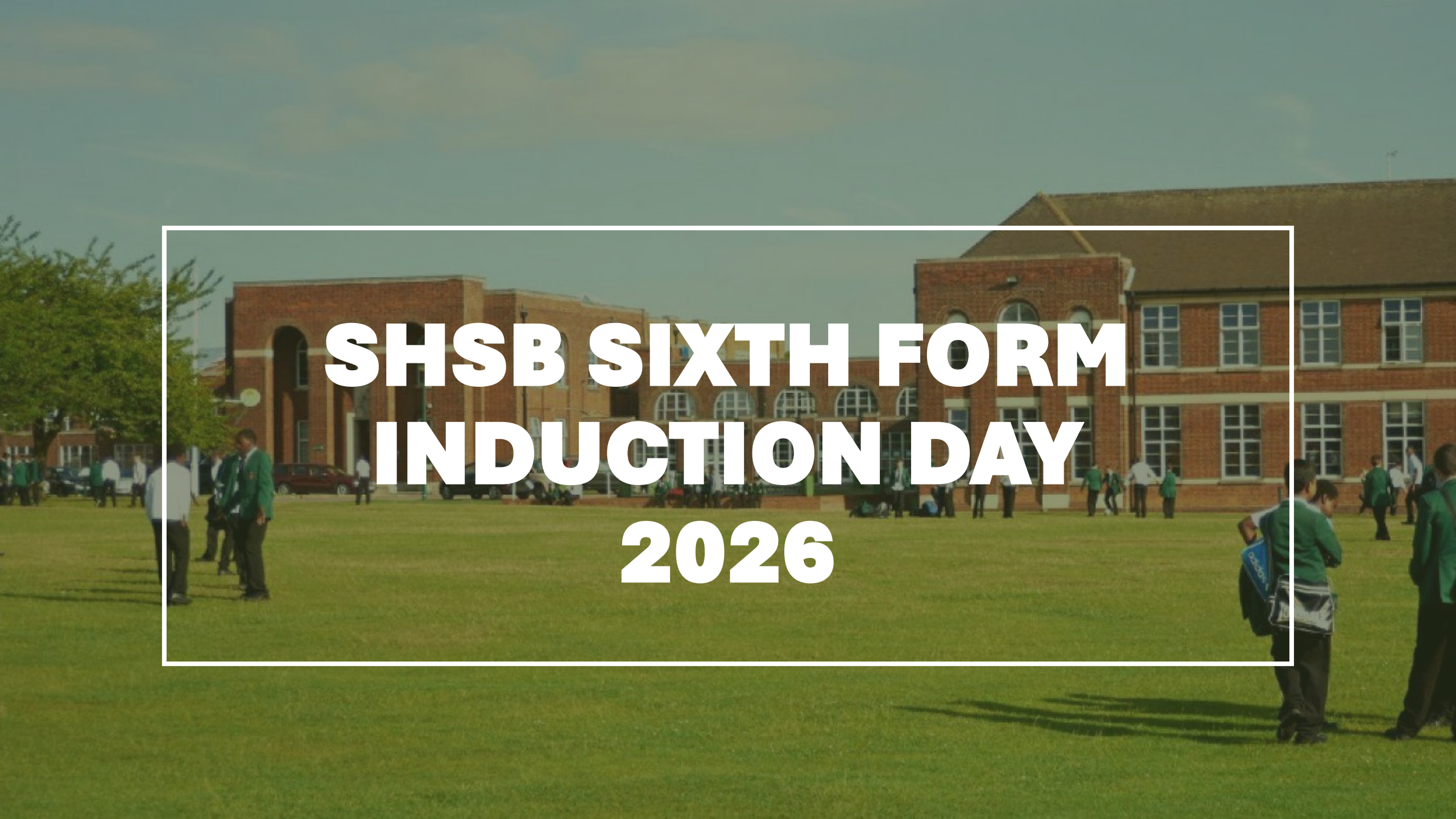
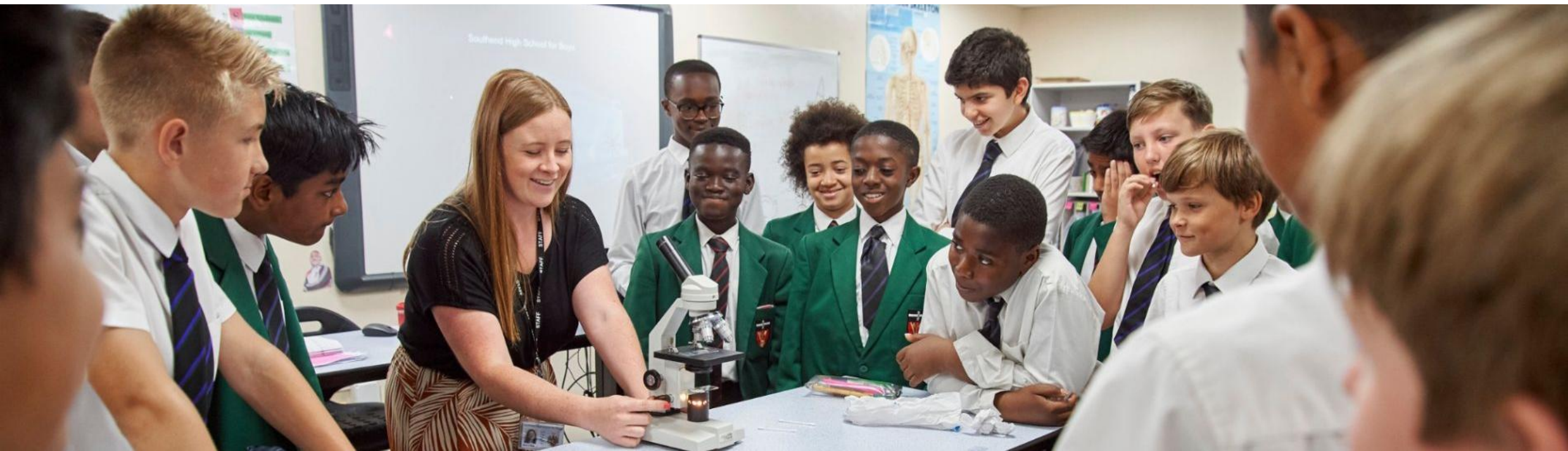

- You will be assessed throughout the year in class (50%)
- With a final exam in April (50%)
- Your UCAS predicted grade will be based upon your Year 12 final grade.
- Therefore, it is vital that you work your hardest in Year 12!

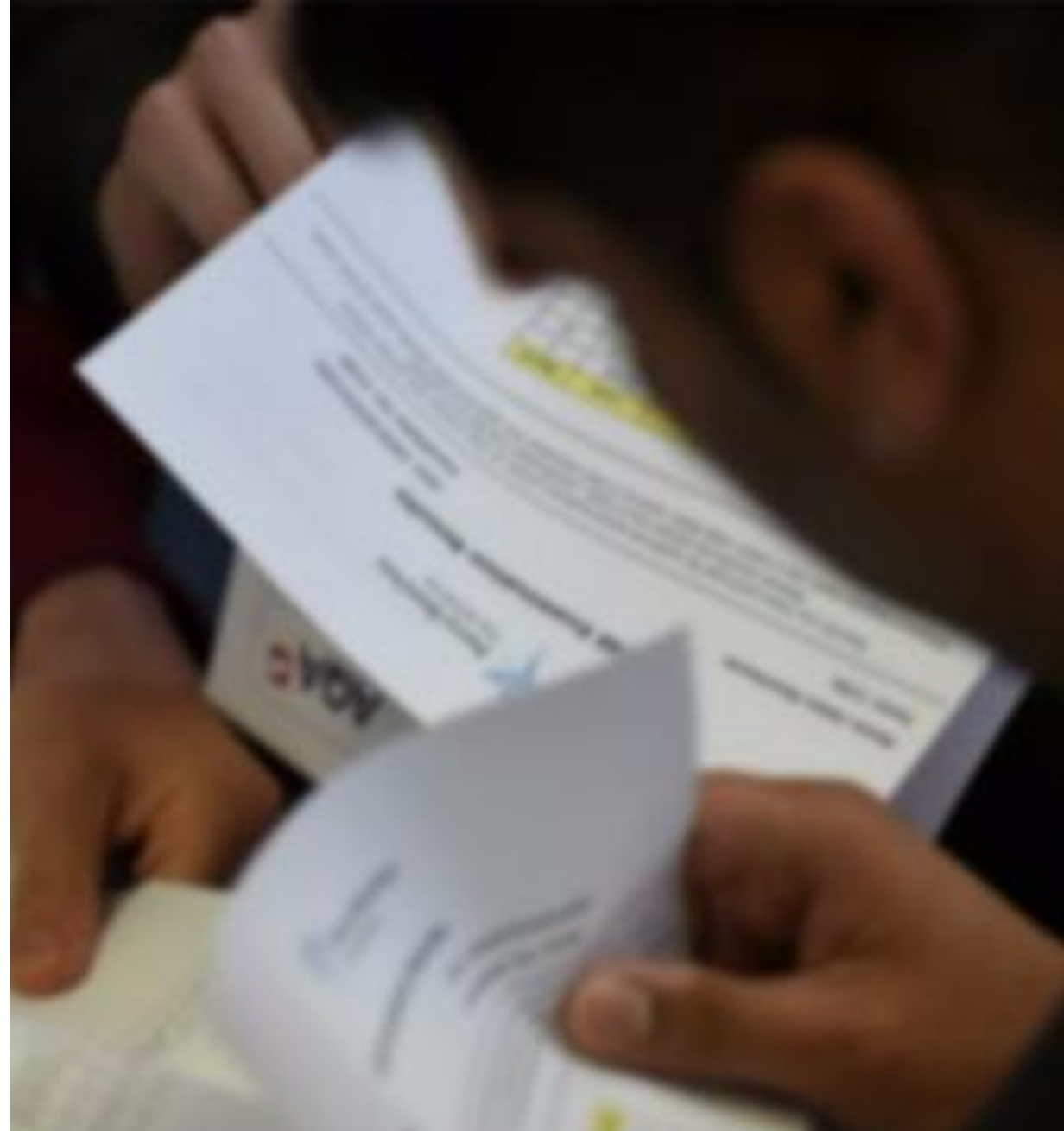


WHAT TO DO ON RESULTS DAY

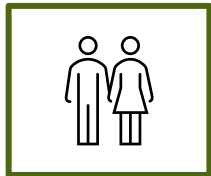
